## **COVID RULES FOR ART CYCLES AT IHR**



A) For IUI			
1. 1 <sup>st</sup> cycle	<ul> <li>Wife –</li> <li>RT-PCR on Day 2/3</li> <li>RT-PCR 1-2 days before anticipated trigger</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Husband –</li> <li>RT-PCR 1-2 days before anticipated trigger.</li> </ul>	
2. In any subsequent cycle within 3 months of RT-PCR	<ul> <li>Wife –</li> <li>RT-PCR on Day 2/3</li> <li>RT-PCR 1-2 days before anticipated trigger</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Husband –</li> <li>RT-PCR 1-2 days before anticipated trigger.</li> </ul>	

B) For OPU Cycles		
<ul> <li>Wife –</li> <li>RT-PCR before starting stimulation on Day 1/2</li> <li>RT-PCR 1-2 days before anticipated trigger</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Husband –</li> <li>RT-PCR on 8<sup>th</sup> day of stimulation (if Sunday, then 7<sup>th</sup> day), following which both cryo sample and fresh sample can be given within 7 days.</li> </ul>	

C) For OD Cycles		
<ul> <li>Wife –</li> <li>RT-PCR at the beginning of endometrial preparation</li> <li>RT-PCR one day before starting progesterone</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Husband –</li> <li>RT-PCR at the beginning of endometrial preparation of wife. (To give semen sample within 7 days for cryopreservation).</li> <li>RT-PCR one day before starting progesterone for wife. (Fresh semen sample for IVF within one week).</li> </ul>	

D) For Embryo Donation Cycle / FET Cycle		
<ul> <li>Wife –</li> <li>RT-PCR at the beginning of endometrial preparation</li> <li>RT-PCR one day before starting progesterone</li> </ul>	Husband – • Not Required	

- RT-PCR to be done irrespective of previous COVID recovery duration / antibody titres/ vaccination status of the couple.
- Validity of the tests shall be 7 days.
