- RT-PCR/RAT to be done irrespective of previous COVID recovery duration / antibody titres/ vaccination status of the couple.
- Any patient with history of COVID positive in past, a gap of minimum of 4 weeks (from the 1st positive report) should be there before any elective procedure except delivery. It is advisable to follow ASA Guidelines.
- Requesting all consultants to take past history of COVID positive from all patients.
- Any patient with history of COVID positive in past, PAC is compulsory and also require High Risk Consent
- RAT maximum validity 48 hours.
- RT-PCR maximum validity 5 days.
