

COVID RULES FOR ADMISSION AT IHR

If a patient has A history of being COVID POSITIVE & WAS IN INSTITUTIONAL QUARANTINE :

- 1. No admission till the patient is discharged from Institutional Quarantine
- 2. If a patient comes within first 7 days after discharge , pt. can be admitted after repeat negative RAT in room number 109/112 with PPE kit.
- 3. From 8th day onwards, patient can be admitted to any room after a repeat negative RAT.
- 4. Discharge summary will need to be furnished during time of admission at IHR.
- 5. RT-PCR not to be repeated within 3 months of being COVID POSITIVE.
- 6. After 3 months, a fresh RT-PCR will need to be done.

If a patient has A history of being COVID POSITIVE & WAS IN HOME ISOLATION :

- 1. No admission for the first 14 days (from the date of 1st positive report)
- 2. If a patient comes within 15th to 21st day (from the date of 1st positive report), patient can be admitted after repeat negative RAT in room number 109/112 with PPE kit.
- 3. After 21st day, patient can be admitted to any room after a repeat negative RAT.
- 4. RT-PCR not to be repeated within 3 months.
- 5. After 3 months, a fresh RT-PCR will need to be done
